

## Casual Dress Days:

### Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday

**Casual Dress for boys** consists of a two-piece outfit: pant/short and polo shirt.

**Casual Dress for girls** consists of a two-piece outfit: pant/capris/short/skirt/skort/jumper and polo shirt.



## Formal Dress Days: Wednesday

**Formal Dress for boys** consists of a three piece outfit: pant/short, button-up white shirt (long or short sleeved), tie or black sweater vest, or black blazer with tie.

**Formal Dress for girls** consists of a three-piece outfit: pant/capris/short/skirt/skort/ jumper, button-up white shirt (long or short sleeved), and tie.

## Bottoms

- **Boys' Pants:** black or khaki
- **Boys' Shorts:** black or khaki (Can be worn from August to October and from April to June)
- **Girls' Pants:** black or khaki
- **Girls' Shorts/Skort/Skirts/Capri/Jumpers:** black, khaki or approved plaid (Can be worn from August to October and from April to June without tights)

## Tops

- **Girls' and Boys' Shirts:** collared white button-up (long or short sleeved)
- **Sweater Vest:** black
- **Button-Up Cardigan Sweaters:** black, white, or khaki
- **Ties:** black, college rule (black and gold), approved plaid
- **Girls' and Boys' Blazer:** black
- **Girls' and Boys' Polos:** black, gold, white

## Uniform Shoes

Solid colored white/black/brown dress shoes or tennis shoes are allowed. Tennis shoes may have small black or white highlights. Solid colored white/black/tan tights or socks are allowed.

## DRESS AND APPEARANCE



We want our students to become accustomed to dressing for success. The school dress code seeks to compliment and reflect those high standards while also helping maintain the students' focus on the task at hand and on issues of personal character. The International Magnet Schools have two main types of uniforms: the formal and the casual uniform.

### Please keep the following uniform guidelines in mind:

(For a complete list, refer to the parent handbook.)

- Hair color should be a natural color.
- No Mohawk haircuts.
- No fake fingernails or makeup.
- No exterior labels.
- All accessories should meet FIMS standards according to the parent handbook.
- Skirts, skorts, jumpers, and shorts must be no more than 2 inches from the top of the knee.
- No skinny pants and no leggings worn as pants.
- No neon yellow or yellow polo shirts.
- No collarless shirts or v-neck button-up shirts.
- No tight fitting clothing.
- No flip-flops, sandals, open-toed shoes, clogs, crocks, boots, and heels.
- No large hoop earrings.
- No hats, hoods, gloves, or sunglasses worn in the building.

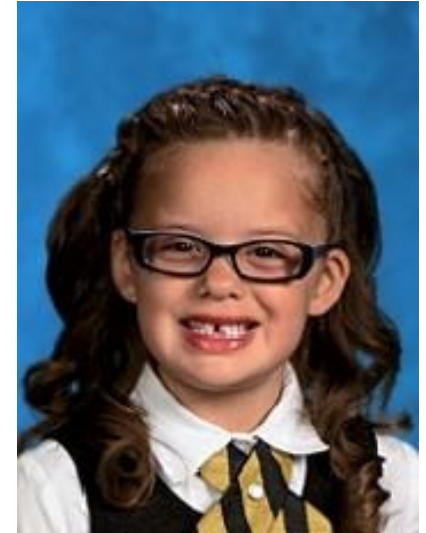
